General Information

Florida faculty:

On site: Meals and refreshments are covered by the department

Air travel: For those attending the graduate retreat, your travel will be reimbursed by the Graduate program. For those coming for the Molecular Medicine retreat only, the department can offset up to \$500 towards your air fare (same as the Graduate program).

Rental car: The department will provide a proportionate amount of the rental car bill for the extra day to attend the MM retreat, or a two day rental for the few that are coming only for the MM retreat only.

Lodging: For Florida faculty there are three options. The preferred option for those staying for the retreat is the conference center. If you are coming only for the retreat, we suggest the Saddleback Inn. The Department will cover one night at the Conference Center, or the two nights at the Saddleback Inn.

- **UCLA conference center:** For those staying for the graduate retreat, we have reserved 5 condolets for the night of the 23rd. This is ONLY for those who are staying on at the graduate retreat since there will be no extra rooms available on Sunday. Each unit has two bedrooms, two baths, and a common living area. These will be allocated on a first come first served basis, and will accommodate 10 Florida faculty. Just let us know. We will coordinate with the Graduate Division, and try to make sure you will not have to move the rest of your stay.

- **Saddleback Inn:** For faculty attending only the MM retreat only, and wish to stay a second night, the best option is the Saddleback Inn (13-minute drive to conference center). It requires a two requires a two-night stay, with an average price of about \$167 per night. They offer parking, wifi and buffet breakfast. We ask that you make your own reservations for the Saddleback Inn: Phone number (800) 858-3334.

- *Lake Arrowhead Resorts:* A more expensive option is the Lake Arrowhead Resort (13-minute drive to conference center) at average cost of \$290 per night with only parking included. We ask that you make your own reservations for the Lake Arrowhead Resorts: Phone number (909) 336-1511.

La Jolla faculty:

On site: Meals and refreshments are covered by the department

Travel: As agreed from the beginning, there will be no reimbursement for travel from La Jolla

Lodging: There are quite a few La Jolla faculty who are coming up for the day only. But driving both ways in one day may seem onerous for some. Although the department will not cover lodging, if you want to stay over one night at your expense, the easiest and cheapest will be Sunday night after the retreat. The Saddleback Inn will allow one night for Sunday night (September 24) at a cost of \$150 for that night only. We ask that you make your own arrangements by calling the hotel (Saddleback Inn: Phone number (800) 858-3334.)

If you are planning drive up the night before, there are several hotels nearby to make your trip a bit shorter in the morning. Please contact them directly.
